

SCIENTIST DEVELOPMENT AWARD

- Mentored Career Development Award
- For: 1. Early stages of career (~ fellows) OR
 2. Without significant prior research experience
- Support: Salary + research and/or education
- Amount: Up to \$225,000
- Term: 2 years of funding, competitive renewal year 3
- Letter of Intent Deadline: July 1, 2024
- Application Deadline: August 1, 2024

INVESTIGATOR AWARD

- Mentored Career Development Award
- For: Early career, usually with faculty appointment, during period when developing K award or equivalent funding
- Successful candidates will have:
 - 1. A developed project with preliminary data generated themselves
 - A track record of academic productivity, i.e., publications
 - 3. Outlined how award will lead to NIH K grant funding (or equivalent) and future independence

INVESTIGATOR AWARD

- Amount: Up to \$375,000
 - \$125,000 per year
 - \$75 K salary
 - \$50 K research + training
- Term: 3 years
- Letter of Intent Deadline: July 1, 2024
- Application Deadline: August 1, 2024

SDA vs. IA: WHICH IS RIGHT FOR ME?

Scientist Development Award

- Fellows
- > 4 (5 for peds) years from start of fellowship NOT eligible
- ARP w/in 3 yrs of terminal deg
- Don't need a lot of experience or preliminary data

Investigator Award

- Faculty Appt
- > 8 (9 for peds) years from start of fellowship NOT eligible
- ARP w/in 6 yrs of terminal deg
- Need prior experience + pubs

• **Amount:** \$75 K

• Term: 1 Year

Deadlines:

1. June 3, 2024

K SUPPLEMENT

• **Amount**: \$100 K (up to 50K per yr)

• Term: 2 Years

August 1, 2024

R BRIDGE

• **Amount:** \$200 K (up to 50K per yr)

• Term: 2 Years

1. June 3, 2024

2. October 1, 2024


